

For those who are interested in learning how to download YouTube videos for later showing in the classroom (independent of the internet), follow these instructions:

1. Download Firefox in the Software Center if you have not already.
2. Paste this link into the address bar in Firefox: <https://addons.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/addon/1-click-youtube-video-downl/?src=ss>
3. Click the green button that says **+ Add to Firefox**
4. Click **Install Now** in the pop-up window
5. Click **Restart Now** (Firefox will close and reopen – your computer will not restart)
6. Once Firefox is opened, you'll be able to navigate to a YouTube video and see a download button that wasn't there before. I usually download the video as mp4, and then it's viewable with Quicktime (also in the Software Center).
